
Meet our Children & Family Ministries Director, Whitney Robinson, p. 2




Free Handbell Concert Thursday, June 19 7:00 p.m., Sanctuary

Notes from the Past

SIXTY YEARS AGO: On June 4, 1954, the Official Board voted to acquire a water fountain to be installed in the church.

The June 6, 1954, bulletin announced that Wesley Foundation Director Joe Elmore and his family would be leaving for New York, where Mr. Elmore would begin work on his doctorate.

The June 13, 1954, bulletin reported that the Million for Millsaps campaign had been so successful that work would begin immediately on the library.

The June 27, 1954, bulletin carried this announcement: "Last Sunday it was decided by a majority vote of the congregation present to hold the morning worship service at 9 o'clock to avoid suffering from the extreme summer heat which is so keenly felt in our Sanctuary."

FIFTY YEARS AGO: For a number of years there were no Sunday morning services at the church when the University had commencement. At the Official Board meeting on June 16, 1964, "Mr. Sneed moved that services be held on graduation Sundays. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously."

At the June 16, 1964, meeting of the Official Board Reverend Clark brought up the policy "concerning the seating of Colored people if they should attempt to attend services." Much discussion followed. "Mr. Gafford moved that the board commend the pastor [Duncan Clark] for his leadership and pledge its support during the crucial months ahead. The motion passed unanimously."

Wesley Foundation Director Don Anderson preached on June 28, 1964, "while Reverend Clark is studying in Boston University."

FORTY YEARS AGO: The June 2, 1974, bulletin reminded members that "Tens of thousands lost all their possessions on April 3 when tornadoes hit eleven states" and that there were places in Africa that had had no rain in six years. The Bishop asked all to contribute to the United Methodist Committee on Relief.

THIRTY YEARS AGO: The June 17, 1984, bulletin reported that "John Garrott, one of our own, was ordained Deacon last week at the Annual Conference. We are proud of John and congratulate him. His appointment is to Iuka-North."

Reverend Wallace Roberts, director of the United Methodist Hour of Mississippi, was our preacher on June 24, 1984.

TWENTY YEARS AGO: Those received by profession of faith and confirmation on June 5, 1994, were Lollie Britt, Flyn Flesher, Eriika Paine, Mary Linley Swaney, and Lydia Wright-Jackson.

TEN YEARS AGO: The June 13, 2004, bulletin welcomed "our newly appointed associate pastor, Claire Dobbs, who comes to us from First United Methodist Church in Columbus. Claire, a native of Amory, is a graduate of Ole Miss and Duke Divinity School. We are delighted to have her at O-U and look forward to her ministry with us."

Shirley Perry gave the program at the Primetimers' meeting on June 18, 2004.
